Acrylics (Beginner) with **Anne Walker**
Fridays 1:00 – 4:00 pm

This class is for students who want to learn the basics of using acrylics, color, brush strokes, composition, and technique. The class includes discussion, demonstration, handouts, and coaching on individual work. This series is a combination of fun, information and inspiration.

Acrylics (Intermediate & Advanced)
with **Anne Walker**
Thursdays 9:00 am - Noon

Learn basic sketching, values, color, composition, and paint mixing. Use iridescent, interference and metallic paints. Texturize with modeling paste, sand, and gels. Learn about methods and styles of classic painters. Enjoy demonstrations, presentations, and individual instruction.

Fundamentals of Drawing Made Easy
(Beginner) with **Helen Solomon**
Saturdays 1:00 3:00 beginning in October

Students will learn the basics of still life, landscape and seascape including perspective and vanishing point, figures and portraits.

Oil Painting (All Levels) with **Linda Scola**
January – April Fridays 9:00 – 11:30 am

Students learn composition, color mixing and technique while painting along as the instructor demonstrates a variety of subjects. Paintings start with a loose composition of shapes and values in a neutral tone. Layers of color are added to fully develop a finished painting.

Come enjoy exploring the brilliant colors of pastels while trying both traditional and non-traditional methods. You'll work on paper, sanded boards, and canvas. Preparation will include using a variety of washes.

Techniques & Shortcuts (All Levels)

Students learn techniques and shortcuts to achieve great results quickly. Learn to finish your art in 1 or 2 classes. Joe's a working, award-winning fine artist, illustrator, designer and teacher. Learn how to beautify and finish the art you want to do while having a lot of fun.

Watercolor (Beginner & Intermediate)

Thursdays 1:00 – 3:00 pm

This class explores watercolor painting styles (including dry brush, wet on wet, detailed, and loose), colors and color mixing, and how to sketch before painting. Brushes needed: one large wash, one medium size, and one liner. Come ready to have fun while creating pleasing paintings.

This class targets artists who want to enhance their painting techniques including knowledge of design and color theory. Though designed for Intermediate to advanced, all levels are welcome to explore the watercolor medium. Reference material provided by instructor and students.
